

# EPISODE 5: "WHO CAN I RUN TO?"

## HEBREWS 3:1-6

### CONTEXT

In this episode, we will discover why Christ is better than Moses. Adversity can cause us to consider giving up what's best for what's familiar. However, who should we run to to overcome adversity? We'll see in this episode. Let's take a look at why considering Christ is better than going back to old, inferior ways.

#### Moses, God's Servant
