Saint Mark Baptist Church Scholarship Application

Background

Saint Mark Baptist Church will provide, to qualified applicants, a Scholarship award for graduating high school seniors and/or students currently enrolled full-time (based upon 12 hours or more) in either a two-year or four-year accredited college working toward their first degree or certificate program. They may continue to apply as long as they are working on their first undergraduate degree or certificate program.

Qualifications

- Applicant must be a member of Saint Mark Baptist Church, who has Completed New Membership Orientation, received the Right Hand of Fellowship.
- Currently involved in Ministry or Community Involvement (Ministry involvement will be verified by Ministry/Community Directors)

You are <u>not</u> eligible for this Scholarship if you are currently on Academic Probation/Suspension or pursuing a second degree.

Requirements

- A completed type-written scholarship application
- An official high school transcript (for high school seniors) or college transcript (for continuing students)

Must be in sealed envelope, mailed directly to church or emailed to mhobbs@smark.org from High School or College

- Acceptance letter from college (copy only) High School Seniors
- Three letters of recommendation (type-written)
- Current Ministry Involvement (High School Seniors only)
- Current Photos (ONLY) send to zlherts@smark.org

Frequently Asked Questions

Below is a list of questions that you may have regarding this scholarship application process. If you have any specific questions, please contact the church office at 501-663-3955, ext.217. Thanks for applying for the Saint Mark Scholarship!

- **Q:** What if I attend only one semester after receiving the scholarship?
- **A:** If you are the recipient of a scholarship, all proceeds are sent to you in <u>your name</u> and the <u>school's name</u> each semester. If you do not enroll the second semester, the proceeds are forfeited.
- **Q:** What if I am attending a two-year technical college? Do I still qualify for the scholarship?
- **A:** Yes. This scholarship is for those attending accredited 2-year or 4-year institutions.
- **Q:** Can I apply for the scholarship if I plan to only attend part-time (6 hours or less)
- A: No. This scholarship is based upon students enrolled full-time (12 hours or more) that are pursuing their first undergraduate degree.
- **Q:** What if I want to go back to school to get another degree? Can I apply?
- A: No. This scholarship is only for students that are pursuing their first undergraduate degree.
- **Q:** How is the scholarship process reviewed and awarded?
- A: The Scholarship Committee will make recommendations based on a review of all materials submitted. The review process is *blind*, and is based on achievement, personal essay, recommendations, ministry involvement, community recommendation, and financial need.
