

# EPISODE 6: "LEARNING FROM THE PAST"

## HEBREWS 3:7-11

### CONTEXT

In this episode, we will look at the consequence of rejecting Christ. Rest is a promise God wants us to experience by faith in Christ. However, that promise cannot be experienced with an unbelieving, disobedient heart. What can prevent us from entering God's rest? Let's look at Israel's past failures and the lessons we can learn from them.

### Israel's Past Failures
