Memory Verse: Leviticus 19:18 (CSB)

"Do not take revenge or bear a grudge against members of your community, but love your neighbor as yourself; I am the Lord."

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

## **SINGLES**

- 1. How can the command to love our neighbors as ourselves be practically applied in your daily interactions with others as singles?
- 2. As a single, what challenges do you face in treating others with love and kindness? How can you overcome these challenges?
- 3. In a culture that often emphasizes self-centeredness, how can you actively demonstrate love and kindness toward those around you?

## SINGLE PARENT

- 1. As single parents, how do you balance the demands of parenting with the command to love your neighbor as yourself?
- 2. What support or encouragement do you need from your church community in order to fulfill the commandment to love others?
- 3. In challenging times, how can you rely on your faith and the support of your church family to maintain a loving and forgiving attitude?

#### **TEENS**

- 1. How can you apply the principle of loving your neighbors in your interactions at school, with friends, and in your family relationships?
- 2. What challenges do you face in treating others with kindness, and how can your faith guide you in overcoming these challenges?
- 3. How can parents and the church community support you in living out the command to love others, especially in the midst of peer pressure and societal expectations?

## **YOUNG ADULT**

- 1. In the transition to adulthood, how can you navigate relationships, work, and social interactions while keeping the command to love your neighbors in mind?
- 2. As you pursue career goals and personal aspirations, how can you balance ambition with a commitment to loving others?
- 3. How can the church community support you in building meaningful relationships and living out the call to love your neighbors as themselves?

## **MARRIED COUPLES**

- 1. In what practical ways can you exemplify the love commanded in Leviticus 19:18 in your homes and communities?
- 2. How can you navigate conflicts and disagreements while still adhering to the principle of treating others as themselves, as emphasized in Leviticus 19:18?
- 3. Discuss examples of mutual respect and consideration within a marriage, applying the idea of treating each other as you would like to be treated (Leviticus 19:18).

#### **FAMILY**

- 1. How can you intentionally create an atmosphere of love and respect, reflecting the command in Leviticus 19:18?
- 2. In what ways can your family members support each other through challenges, keeping in mind the principle of treating others as oneself from Leviticus 19:18?
- 3. Discuss the role of forgiveness and reconciliation in family life, drawing on the guidance of Leviticus 19:18.

## **WIDOWED**

- 1. Considering the challenges faced by widows or widowers, how do you think the church community actively demonstrate love and support as instructed in Leviticus 19:18?
- 2. How has your idea of the resurrection changed over time?

- What has your child taught you about this verse?

- 1. How can you establish a foundation of love and respect in your marriage, reflecting the teachings of Leviticus 19:18?
- 2. Discuss the importance of communication and understanding in the early stages of marriage, incorporating the command to love others as oneself (Leviticus 19:18).
- 3. In what ways can the church community support and mentor you in your journey of building a Christ-centered marriage, guided by Leviticus 19:18?

#### **EMPTY NESTERS**

- 1. In what ways can you redirect your focus on serving others and the community, applying the principle of love from Leviticus 19:18?
- 2. Discuss the challenges and opportunities that you face in maintaining strong, Christ-centered relationships, guided by Leviticus 19:18.
- 3. How can the church provide fellowship and purpose for you, encouraging you to continue living out the command of treating others as you want to be treated (Leviticus 19:18)?

- 3. How can divorced individuals cultivate a spirit of love and kindness in your interactions with others, guided by the principle of treating people as you want to be treated (Leviticus 19:18)?
