How Do I Share My Faith? Did Jesus Preach A Revival In Hell?

Understanding 1 Peter 3:19

Using the example of Christ to share the message of Christ

Sharing the faith should not be a chore or stressful experience. Christ's death helps take the fear and stress out of sharing the gospel because Christ went to the depths of hell to share the faith. Christ shows how we can go to the worst places and yet the Gospel still has the power to move forward.

¹⁸ For Christ also suffered for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring you to God. He was put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, ¹⁹ in which he also went and made proclamation to the spirits in prison ²⁰ who in the past were disobedient, when God patiently waited in the days of Noah while the ark was being prepared. In it a few — that is, eight people — were saved through water.

Why did Christ preach a revival in hell? Two viewpoints to consider while trying to understand 1 Peter 3:19.

1. The first is that the spirits in prison were _____ waiting on final judgment (Genesis 6).
